

Siegfried Jung, born in Timișoara, studied orchestral music, majoring in tuba, at the Franz Liszt Academy of Music in Weimar under the tutelage of Professor Walter Hilgers. He has been a tuba player in the Mannheim National Theatre Orchestra since 1999. He has been a member of the Bayreuth Festival Orchestra since 2018 and has performed several times as a soloist with the Mannheim National Theatre Orchestra, and he made his debut in Romania in 2015 with the Filarmonica "George Enescu" Bucharest in the Ateneul Roman. This was followed by invitations to the philharmonic orchestras of the cities of Bacau and Targu Mures, as well as several appearances at the "Timișoara Muzicale" festival together with the Banat Philharmonic Orchestra. Further performances as a soloist with orchestras have taken place with the Kapella Orchestra in St. Petersburg, the Thuringian Symphony Orchestra in Saalfeld and Rudolstadt, with the Sofia Philharmonic Orchestra, and with the Vienna Concert -Verein Orchestra in the Brahms Hall of the legendary Vienna Musikverein. His debut CD, "Paesaggio", was released in 2017 together with the Mannheim National Theatre Orchestra on the Coviello Classics Label. Two further Albums with works for tuba and harp and tuba and piano were also released by Coviello Classics in 2019 and 2020, and he has been touring together with pianist Susanne Endres as Duo Compagni since autumn 2023. His new Album „Porteño“ released in May 2024 on the Label Haenssler Classic.
